## Job Description for Trustees for Bloody Good Period (Voluntary, Unpaid)

Bloody Good Period is the UK's leading menstrual charity, providing period supplies and menstrual education to asylum seekers, refugees and those less likely to access them.

We are looking to recruit a new member to the board of trustees. The board meets with the CEO every six weeks, and more often as necessary.

We strongly encourage applications from Black and People of Colour, and from those who have lived experience – either themselves or parent/guardian - of seeking asylum and/or as a refugee.

While the successful candidate will be selected purely on merit, in the event of a tie between two candidates with equal suitability, we may select a candidate with lived experience of the issues we are seeking to address through our work.

We recognise that many potential candidates who bring the voice and experience that we need, may have had less opportunity to develop a track record in leadership/governance/trustee roles. This is not a requirement for this role. But we know that it is critical that the successful candidate feels comfortable and confident in the role. Bloody Good period prioritises the development needs of everyone who works with us including in this role.

Please note that although unremunerated, this role will pay expenses including for child care.

You will be a passionate individual who will:

- Bring your expertise and skills to help us deliver our ambitious strategy and our vision to do whatever it takes to achieve menstrual equity.
- Together with fellow trustees, ensure that Bloody Good Period is effectively governed including:
  - Collaborating with the CEO and her team to shape strategy;
  - Working with Trustee colleagues to ensure accountability, probity and integrity in the use of BGP resources in service of the mission and objectives of the organisation;
